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## **US News and World Report Rankings**

Once again, our schools (students and staff) continue to shine as compared with Michigan schools:

**Creekside** = #22 out of 2,601 or Top 1% (last year #14 out of 2,633 or Top 1%)

**Lakes** = #108 out of 2,601 or Top 5% (last year #218 out of 2,633 or Top 8%)

**Round** = #261 out of 2,601 or Top 10% (last year #320 out of 2,633 or Top 12%)

**Village** = #619 out of 2,601 or Top 24% (last year #879 out of 2,633 or Top 33%)

**Farms Intermediate** = #162 out of 1,979 or Top 10% (last year #213 out of 1,998 or Top 11%)

**Middle School** = #66 out of 1,979 or Top 4% (last year #108 out of 1,998 or Top 5%)

**Hartland High School** = #69 out of 1,135 or Top 6% (last year #153 out of 1,163 or Top 13%)

On average, district schools earned a +3.3% improvement when ranking in the Top Percentage of schools. Again, congratulations to the passionate and hard-working staff and students who work hard to meet their individual goals. I am so proud of everyone and the continued success of Hartland Consolidated Schools.

## **JK-4 Parent Perception Survey Results**

Thank you, parents, for filling out the survey. We had 549 families (or 43% of families) in grades JK to Fourth respond. Based on these responses, I proudly present the following data.

96% of respondents give a grade of A or B to their school

97% Strongly Agree or Agree (SA or A) that the school promotes academic success

98% SA or A that their student is treated with respect

94% SA or A that the school keeps them well informed regarding their child's progress

97% SA or A that the school is a welcoming place

97% SA or A that the school is a safe place

93% SA or A with the effort to teach social-emotional skills

94% SA or A that the school encourages them to be an active partner

98% SA or A that adults care about their child

94% SA or A that the school clearly teaches behavior expectations

13% SA or A that their child has experienced bullying (23%, 28%, 28% over the last three years)

3% SA or A that their child has experienced racial/ethnic conflict in school (7%, 3%, 4% over the last three years)
