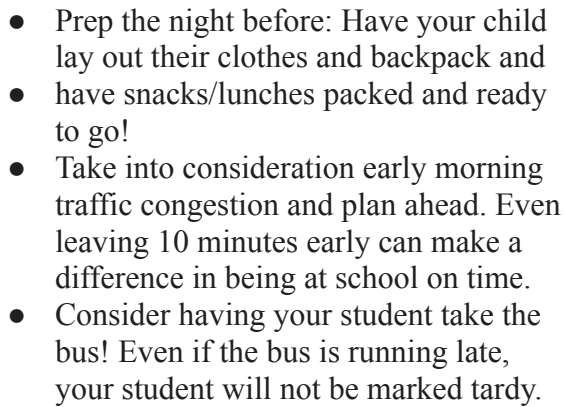
Although it is not encouraged for your student to miss five or more days of school, short-term independent study is an option that may be available. [Click HERE](#) for more information regarding this option.

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Volunteer Clearance

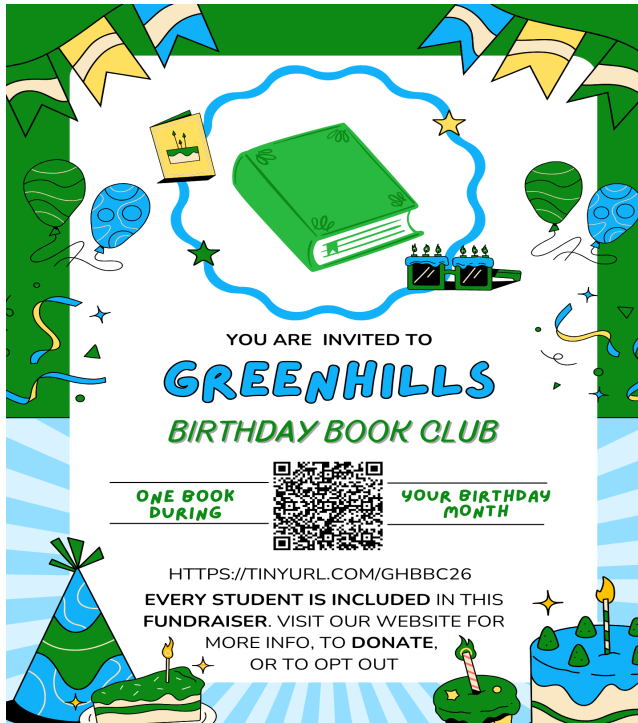

Investing in Excellence: Partnering for Our Students As we jump into a great new school year, we want to spotlight our incredible partnership with the **Eureka Schools Foundation (ESF)**. Last year EUSD received nearly **\$8,000 less per student** in state funding than many neighboring districts, a structural gap totaling nearly **\$29 million district-wide**. While state funds cover basic operations, our district spends **\$2 million annually on vital enrichment programs** like libraries, athletics, performing arts, visual arts, technology/STEAM, and teacher collaboration. ESF works directly with our community to help cover these costs and bridge the funding gap.
