

Educational Rights of Immigrant Students

Commitment to Equal Access

All students, regardless of their immigration status or family background, have the right to attend public school, participate in school activities, and receive a high-quality education in an inclusive and supportive environment.

Campus Access and School Safety

Schools follow legal requirements regarding campus access and do not permit immigration enforcement officers on campus without a valid judicial warrant or court order. Additionally, schools do not request social security numbers or inquire about the citizenship or immigration status of students or their families unless required by law.

Student Information and Privacy

Schools are committed to protecting student privacy and do not share personal information about students or their family members for immigration enforcement purposes unless legally required by a court order or judicial subpoena.
