### **TEACHING DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Design and implement curriculum and lesson plans for individualized and group instruction, schedule instructional periods, provide direct instructional support to students with special needs, individually and/or in the general education classroom setting, modify curriculum and instruction that enhance the student's learning of the core curriculum or alternative curriculum and provide for continued development in areas of student's strengths, assist with planning individualized education programs, and write goals and objectives using CAPA standards or district Standard and Benchmarks as appropriate.

- Provide consultation to staff and parents of special needs students.
- Conduct assessments, develop individualized educational programs (IEP), coordinate and participate as a member of IEP meetings, provide instruction as required by the IEP, monitor the implementation of the IEP, and evaluate student progress on a regular basis.
- Train and provide work direction and guidance to assigned instructional assistant(s).
- Participate in special education staff meetings and site faculty meetings and foster disability awareness.
- Evaluate the ongoing effectiveness of the program in cooperation with Principal and Director of Pupil Services.
- Perform Special Education Case Management of students in class.
- Trained in CPI (Crisis Prevention Intervention) strategies.
