

IMPORTANT UPDATES

What is an initial CALPADS affirm?

It is a process for manually adopting a student's active plan that does not appear in SEIS (i.e. Out-of-State IEP, Non-SEIS IEP). This process allows you to update an old SEIS record to the current plan or create a benchmark IEP for an Out-of-State student. It will allow Case Managers to create an Interim Placement and 30-day Meeting Amendment, ensuring a continuation of service provision.

DLU (District Level User) will complete this process, it is no longer available for Providers.

CAASPP and **ELPAC** Report

The CAASPP and ELPAC manual download has been updated for 2025-2026. You can find the ELPAC Report under the Reports dropdown in SEIS.

Manual Upload to TOMS

TOMS cleared all students' supports and accommodations. All students must be reuploaded for the new year. This will be done through the manual upload to TOMS. Please provide your TOMS testing coordinator with the SEIS report to upload into the TOMS system. The SEIS to TOMS nightly export only includes students whose Statewide Assessment form was updated that day. TOMS access codes need to be updated annually.

Official Notification of 2025 Timeline Noncompliance

Due Date October 24th

LEA CEOs (the individuals listed with the CDE as the Superintendent for each LEA) received official notification from the CDE on Monday, August 25, 2025, that they remained noncompliant from the initial 2025 Prong1 Certification extract completed on December 12, 2024.

These LEAs must complete the required student-level corrective actions and update the student's record in CALPADS by **October 24**, **2025**.

If the LEA does not correct the noncompliance and update the student's record by the due date, the noncompliance will be considered overdue and will be a negative factor in the LEA's Annual Determination, slated for release February 2026.

Fall 1 Key Dates

- Recommended zero errors by November 21, 2025.
- SELPA Requested Fall 1 Due date December 5, 2025, to allow for SELPA review.
- Certification Deadline: December 12, 2025 (Annual Determination Data pulled.)
- Amendment Window: December 13, 2025 January 23, 2026 (SELPA approval required.)

Fall 1 DRDP 2025

- Identify students requiring Fall DRDP and begin assessing now.
 - o DRDP is required in the Fall and Spring.

- Access report in SEIS: Searches > SEIS Searches > Fall DRDP 2025.

- Assessment data must be affirmed no later than 12/19/2025.

Degree of Support

The Degree of Support MUST be reported for Census Day for all applicable students.

The create transaction button has been activated for updating program settings or degree of support when an amendment cannot be added to the record. All transactions created using this feature will have an effective date of census day.

To access this feature, go to the current IEP and select the amendment tab. The Button will appear on the right. Create the transaction. You must go to the transaction and edit the new transaction with the needed corrections

 - Transition Goals and Services (high schools only)
- Searches > Shared Searches
 - <80% in Gen Ed-SPP Indicator 5A
 - Code 900 Services
 - If a student is listed on this search, contact your SELPA Program
 Specialist for an alternative service code.
- Student is Eligible with Exit/Date Reason.

Review and comment DNR'd transactions to ensure all FALL 1 data is reported to CALPADS.

Review validation errors and reconcile as needed

Resolve CDDs, Certification errors, and anomalies.

Review snapshot reports and update records as needed

Recommended date for zero fatal errors

12/1 – 12/5

Send reports to local data stewards, site leaders and administrator for approval

SELPA recommends LEA approval to allow for SELPA review and corrections

12/8 - 12/12

LEA Approval Required

SELPA Approval Encouraged

12/15 -1/23

Amendment and SELPA Approval Window

In reviewing your Fall 1 certification report accuracy, ensure your SPED count on:

- 1.1 (Enrollment-Primary and Short Term Enrollment Count by Subgroup) report.
- 16.12 (Student with Disabilities Education Plan by Primary Disability) report.
- 16.15 (Student with Disabilities Student Services Count) report have the same student with disability count by subgroup.

Accountability and Monitoring Report

16.25 - Students with Disabilities – Initial Part B Evaluation 60-Day Timeline Student List.

SELPA recommends that LEAs review this report to ensure that students with consent for assessment from last academic year are timeline compliant for the initial assessments. Pay close attention to monitoring categories.

- Overdue, exceeded 60 days.
- Pending Evaluation, 60-Days Not Yet Exceeded with Days until Overdue less than 30 days.

Student records in this report under a different SELPA or MEET record LEA name have consent for assessment at the prior LEA - you will need to move forward with conducting the assessments for those students who have transferred into your LEA.
