I. OPEN SESSION

The purpose of the LCAP Special Study Session is to provide the Board with an overview of the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) process, review feedback, and examine how the district's goals, metrics, and actions align to support continuous improvement and student outcomes.

A. SUPERINTENDENT'S OPENING UPDATES/ ACTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Approval of Revised 2025-26 Student Calendar for El Dorado, Independence, and Union Mine High Schools (Action)

Due to emergency school closures that occurred from February 17 through February 20, 2026, El Dorado High School, Union Mine High School, and Independence Continuation High School are required to revise their student attendance calendars to ensure compliance with instructional minute requirements.

The proposed revised calendar includes designated makeup days and/or an extended school year to account for the four days of missed instruction.

The District has submitted J-13A waiver requests to the California Department of Education for two of the closure days. If approved, the District will return to the Board with an additional calendar revision to reflect the adjusted number of required makeup days.

The Administration recommends the Board of Trustees approve the revised 2025-26 student calendar for El Dorado, Independence, and Union Mine High Schools.
