RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF Oakland School for the Arts

WHEREAS, the voters approved Proposition 30 on November 6, 2012, adding Article XIII, Section 36 to the California Constitution effective November 7, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Article XIII, Section 36(e) create in the State General Fund an Education Protection Account to receive and disburse revenues as prescribed therein; and

WHEREAS, before June 30 of each year, the governing board of each local educational agency is required to determine and adopt the use of EPA funds for the subsequent fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board of Oakland School for the Arts hereby determines that the Education Protection Account funds expected to be received for fiscal year 2026–27 in the approximate amount of \$3,904,114 will be used solely for instructional purposes and not for administrative salaries or other administrative costs.

In fiscal year 2025-26 the school received approximately \$2,244,678 in Education Protection Account (EPA) Funding. These funds are expected to be spent exclusively on certificated teacher salaries. Final actual expenditures will be reflected in the school's annual EPA report and website posting once year-end financials are finalized.
