Senior Transportation Driver – Part-time Job Description

JOB STATEMENT: This position will fulfill the following tasks, responsibilities, qualifications,

and other assigned duties under the supervision of the Senior Center

Director.

QUALIFICATIONS: Possess a valid Chauffeur license, CDL preferred. All drivers must have a

good driving record and work well with older adults and individuals with

disabilities.

JOB DESCRIPTION: To drive senior vehicles owned by the Hartland Consolidated School

district to provide transportation to senior adults and disabled individuals

and theirs if necessary.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Drive vehicles in a safe and conscientious manner.

- 2. Assist passengers in and out of vehicles and, if necessary, in and out of their homes.
- 3. Help load and unload packages into vehicle.
- 4. Keep cellular phones charged and turned on while on duty.
- 5. Pump gas according to H.C.S.D. bus garage instructions.
- 6. Make sure vehicles are fueled and ready for operation the next day.
- 7. Keep vehicles clean inside and out as time permits.
- 8. Fill out daily route sheet.
- 9. Complete daily safety inspections according to forms and turn into the transportation bus garage.
- 10. Put in work orders as needed and every 3000 miles for oil changes.
- 11. Do shopping and other senior center errands as needed.
